| 1. | Your plan will be checked as a Standard Plan, and after acceptance, it will be kept on file at this office and at any Branch Office which you designate. Submit a sufficient number of copies of the plan to enable distribution to the Branch Offices indicated. | | | | | | |
| 2. | The primary use of the standard plan is to facilitate and expedite checking by Department engineers. The fact that a Standard Plan is on file does not mean that the plans for permits will be checked out of turn. | | | | | | |
| 3. | It will not be necessary to file calculations each time a permit is desired. However, the engineer's or architect's signature, if originally required, must appear on all plans submitted for a permit. | | | | | | |
| 4. | Standard Plans are valid for a period of three years from the date of acceptance or until code changes make the structure non-conforming, whichever time is less. At that time a new application for plan check shall be made, or the plans will be discarded. | | | | | | |
