IMPORTANT NOTICE.....READ CAREFULLY. The resume form contained in this package is a part of the examination and must accompany your application. Information submitted therein will be reviewed by the Deputy Examiners and will assist them in determining your grade for the oral portion of the test. The actual application is entitled “Examination Application” or “Trade License Application” (*see attached*), and is *also* available online at: **www.ladbs.org/lic_apprvd_prod/Trade%20License%20Application.pdf**

Work experience and training shall be detailed and relate mainly to the field of the Deputy license desired. This shall include a minimum of **two** years field experience at the level of Foreman or Supervisor, or at least **four** years as a Journeyman Building Trades Craftsman in a related field. Work experience should be included for the past ten years for new applicants. Deputy Inspectors filing for renewal of their license shall include work experience for the **past three** years in the related field.

Questions for all examinations are based on amendments to various Chapters of the current City of Los Angeles Building Code and City of Los Angeles Information Bulletins and other text and reference materials pertaining to your class of examination. (See attached sheet titled “New Deputy Examination Code References for Examination”) All Deputies should know the duties and responsibilities of a Deputy Inspector.

Effective September 1, 2008, the Fireproofing examination will be referred to as Sprayed Fire-Resistant Materials (SFRM) and be considered as a **Main Activity** license and not a Rider or Controlled Activity. This will require a separate application.

Current Code For All Examinations (Except as noted otherwise):

2002 City of Los Angeles Building Code based on 2001 California Building Code and the 1997 Uniform Building Code (Volumes 1 & 2) and Uniform Building Code 1997 (Volume 3).

Current Code For SFRM (Fireproofing) effective September 1, 2008 Examination:

2008 City of Los Angeles Building Code based on 2007 California Building Code and the 2006 International Building Code (Volumes 1 & 2).

All new applicants require a signed, written verification of experience from their previous and/or current employer on company letterhead. The number of letters should satisfy the minimum qualifying experience. In addition, you must complete the attached resume sheet and include employers telephone number.

New self employed applicants must complete the self employment certification form on page 4.

Submission of ICC Certification copies are required as noted in table on page 5. Copies of other required State and High School Certificates may be required at LADBS’s discretion.

Experiences required for Shotcrete, Fireproofing, DIA or PSC may be waived or substituted for the experiences in other Deputy licenses. Effective September 1, 2008, SFRM will become a main activity license and a L.A. Deputy valid Structural Steel Welding License will not be required to apply for SFRM
2. ICC Certificate titled "Reinforced Concrete Special Inspector" is required. ("RCSI examination" and/or "RCSI Associate" certificates are **not** sufficient.)

EXAMINATION INFORMATION FOR DEPUTY INSPECTOR

The procedures for obtaining a Certificate of Registration as a Deputy Inspector and the regulation of such Inspector are given in Chapter 17 of the Los Angeles Building Code. This Section requires that LADBS examine each applicant as to their experience, training and knowledge.

EXAMINERS

A committee made up of qualified individuals from the building inspectors class appointed by the Superintendent of Building will examine and evaluate each applicant's qualifications for the Certificate applied for in the following manner:

NEW APPLICANTS

**REINFORCED CONCRETE / REINFORCED MASONRY / PRESTRESSED CONCRETE /
STRUCTURAL STEEL AND WELDING / SPRAYED FIRE-RESISTANT MATERIALS**
(Not Soils/Grading Applicants)

A written examination and an oral interview is given to evaluate experience, knowledge and abilities. Examination for all new Deputy Inspector applicants, (except Soils/Grading applicants) are scored and weighed in two parts. Multiple choice Code questions are weighed 50% and the Oral evaluation is weighed 50%. A minimum passing score of 70% is required for the multiple choice Code questions. After passing the Code question portion of the exam, then you will be invited for the Oral evaluation. Effective September 1, 2008, all new or renewal Fireproofing (SFRM) applicants must file a separate application.

RENEWAL DEPUTY INSPECTOR APPLICANT

All renewal Deputy Inspector applicants are scored 100% on the multiple choice Code Examination, no Oral evaluation is necessary. Expired licenses or significant Code changes may require the applicant to be tested as a new Deputy Inspector.

Renewal applicants may pay a reduced fee if they have passed the ICC proctored examination and have a current ICC Certification. Effective September 1, 2008, all Fireproofing renewal applicants who have a combined SSW/FP license must file a separate application for Fireproofing.

GRADING/SOILS DEPUTY NEW AND RENEWAL APPLICANT

1. A multiple choice written examination on the applicable portions of the Los Angeles Building Code and related references.
2. A plan reading examination on the ability to read and comprehend plans and/or geotechnical reports.
3. An oral interview to evaluate qualifying experience knowledge abilities.

New and renewal Deputy Soils/Grading examination will be graded and weighed in three parts: Oral Interview 30%, Plan Reading 35%, and Code questions 35%. The minimum passing score is 70%. New applicants will have a closed book examination and renewal applicants will have an open book code portion of examination.

QUALIFICATIONS: (NEW APPLICANTS)

REINFORCED CONCRETE / REINFORCED MASONRY / PRESTRESSED CONCRETE / STRUCTURAL STEEL AND WELDING/FIRE PROOFING/SHOTCRETE/DIA

1. Refer to table on Page #5 for minimum required qualification details in addition to items noted below.
2. RC, RM, PSC, SSW and FP applicants are required to have a current ICC Certificate before being accepted as an applicant by the City of Los Angeles.
3. PSC applicants must hold a valid Deputy Inspector license for Reinforced Concrete. A separate application and a letter from a Licensed Laboratory or Civil Engineer attesting to their experience are required.
4. Shotcrete applicants must hold a valid Deputy Inspector license for Reinforced Concrete.
5. Fireproofing applicants must have a valid Deputy Inspector license for Structural Steel and Welding.
Effective September 1, 2008, a valid Deputy Inspector license is not required to apply for a SFRM license.
6. DIA applicant must have a valid Deputy Inspector license for RC, RM or SSW.

GRADING/SOILS: (NEW APPLICANTS)

1. Refer to table on Page #5 for details in addition to items noted below.
2. Applicants for Soils/Grading are required to submit a letter attesting to their qualifications from a Licensed Laboratory or Civil Engineer/Geologist specializing in soil mechanics and/or geology.

METHANE BARRIER: (NEW APPLICANTS)

1. In addition to the minimum experience requirements noted on page #5, Methane Barrier Deputy Inspector applicants will be required to have a valid manufacturer's certification as a qualified Special Inspector for at least one approved methane barrier product, prior to submitting an application for examination.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE: See table on Page 5 for details.

APPLYING FOR A NEW OR RENEWAL OF RC/RM/SSW/MB/SFRM (Fireproofing) CLASSIFICATIONS:

1. Complete the application titled "**Examination Application**" or "**Trade License Application**" furnished by LADBS and list the qualifying experience. Write **New** or **Renewal** on the top of the application. *Submit (3) copies of the application.*
2. The application submitted in person must be signed and notarized. Mailed in applications must have the applicants signature notarized by a notary public.
3. Provide two 1 ½" x 2" full-faced photographs taken within one year of the application date. Photo-booth type photos are acceptable. Instant (Polaroid) type photos are not.
4. Provide copies of the ICC, **Wall certificate** and **Wallet card** as part of the Deputy Inspector examination. (Not required for renewals or Methane Barrier applicants.)
ICC Wall Certificate, Wallet card or Proctor exam letter is not required for the first renewal of SFRM when a separate application is filed detaching this from SSW.
5. Complete the resume sheet which is attached to this information packet.
New applicants: Show at least the minimum experience required.
Renewals: Include work experience for the past three years in the related field.
6. **ALL RENEWAL APPLICANTS SHALL INCLUDE A COPY OF THE LICENSE TO BE RENEWED.**
7. New applicants must submit a letter certifying their experience from their employer or complete the Self Employment Certification. (See Required Experience table on page# 5 for details)
8. Submit the appropriate fees for the examination. (See pages 10 and 11 for details)

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

LADBS requires **Renewal** applicants to submit a letter showing the results from the ICC two hour proctored examination. (ICC Mail-In Renewals and ICC seminars WILL NOT be accepted in lieu of the two hour proctored examination).

NOTE: Applications are valid for a period of six months from the cashier's validation date. If the examinations are not taken within that time period, a new application must be filed and a new fee paid.

APPLYING FOR A NEW GRADING CLASSIFICATION:

Follow the same procedures as for RC/PS/SSW except omit number 4. Your application submittal shall include a letter of qualifying experience or a copy of your California Engineers or Architects License.

APPLYING FOR RENEWAL GRADING CLASSIFICATION:

Complete the application in triplicate with notary, submit renewal fee for examination, two passport photos, and the resume sheet which is attached to this information package with the last three years experience listed.

IMPORTANT NOTICE, READ CAREFULLY

It is recommended that you bring the applicable reference books with you, on the day of your scheduled examination:

1. The current edition of the City of Los Angeles Building Code. This is a 3 volume set, consisting of the L.A. Amendments and the California Building Code (CBC) that is based on the Uniform Building Code (UBC), shown as Volumes 1 & 2. Volume 3 is the Uniform Building Code Standards. (See page 1, for the current Code on SFRM effective September 1, 2008)
