### **Exhibit A**

#### **Proposed Standard Modification - All-gender Toilet Facilities**

#### Justification:

California Senate Bill 1194 (Allen) was signed into law on September 29, 2022 to allow cities and jurisdictions to adopt new regulations for multi-stall non-gendered restroom facilities by adopting ordinances. The California Building Standards Commission intends to publish language to the 2022 California Plumbing Code to enable the requirements of that bill. Until those terms are finalized and ordinances adopted, interim mechanisms are necessary to implement that bill's intention to provide equitable toilet facilities for persons of all genders.

The conditions of approval are based on Initial Express Terms issued by the California Standards Commission dated September 15th, 2022. These provisions address the health, safety and welfare intentions of CPC 422.1 which it modifies, by ensuring that equivalent and improved privacy and security are provided for restroom users by:

- 1. Allowing all-gender fixtures to be provided within privacy compartments used by a single occupant.
- 2. Providing improved privacy and security via full height partitions and doors
- 3. Providing designers an alternative to mandatory gendered facilities which some users will perceive as exclusionary and/or discriminatory.

#### **Conditions of Approval:**

- 1. The calculation of required fixtures shall be performed per CPC 422.1.
- 2. For all-gender toilet facilities, the minimum number of fixtures shall be the aggregate calculated at 50 percent female and 50 percent male in accordance with CPC Table 422.1. Where multi-user all-gender facilities are provided in lieu of, or in addition to separate men's and women's facilities, the total number of fixtures collectively shall be used to determine the number of fixtures provided in an occupancy.
- 3. Separate facilities shall not be required where rooms have fixtures designed for single-occupant use by all genders and the water closets and urinals are installed in privacy compartments provided with full-height walls and doors with locking mechanisms.
- 4. The substitution of a water closet for each urinal shall be permitted provided the total number of fixtures installed complies with CPC Table 422.1.
- 5. The total quantity of accessible toilet and urinals provided in all-gender privacy compartments shall not be less than the quantity that would be required in a gendered facility. Where fixtures are clustered in a common location, the minimum number of accessible fixtures shall comply with CBC 11B-213.3.1
- 6. A single occupant privacy compartment may contain a water closet and urinal, provided that the quantity of simultaneously available fixtures required by Table 422.1 is not reduced.
- 7. All-gender lavatories shall not be required to be enclosed within privacy compartments.
