## EXAMINATION INFORMATION DIESEL ENGINEER

#### **DUTIES**

Operation of a stationary diesel or semi-diesel engine or over 50 Horsepower (HP).

### **REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants require 6 months of experience operating the indicated equipment or must have completed a course of training that is, in the opinion of the Examining Board, equivalent to the 6-months experience.

A signed, written verification of experience from your previous or current employer on their company letterhead shall be submitted with your application.

Please attach ONE current (2"x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 1" x 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ ") FULLFACE PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOGRAPH with application.

FILING FEE: \$54.50 ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE: \$27.50

#### **EXAMINATION**

#### **SCHEDULE / LOCATION:**

Applicants will be notified of appointment date and exam location by mail.

**TIME:** 4:00 p.m.

**SCOPE** The examination consists of 50 multiple choice questions pertaining to the

safe operation of any diesel or semi-diesel engine of over 50 HP, and an

oral interview to evaluate the applicant's experience.

**PASSING SCORE:** 70%. Applicants who fail to attain the required passing score in the written

portion of the examination will not be given the oral examination.

#### TIME LIMIT

Failure to appear for the examination within 6 months of the filing date will void the application and the applicant must file a new application and pay another filing fee before another examination will be given.

#### **RE-EXAMINATION**

Applicants who fail to pass their first examination are entitled to a second examination. A waiting period of at least 2 weeks is required for re-examination. No additional fee is required for the second examination. Applicants who fail to pass the second examination are required by Ordinance to wait one month thereafter before they may file another application for the examination, at which time a new application and filing fee is required.

#### **RENEWAL**

The Diesel Engineer license expires one year from the date of issuance. It may be renewed from year to year upon the payment of the annual renewal fee within 30 days after the expiration date, or within 12 months by payment of the renewal fee plus 10% renewal fee for each month after the first.

A VALID WORK I.D. (WITH PICTURE) OR DRIVER'S LICENSE WILL BE REQUIRED WHEN APPLICANTS APPEAR FOR THE EXAMINATION.
