Description of Project and LEA's Determination

The America's Recycling Company Material Recovery Facility (MRF) and Transfer Station (ARC 3) is an approximately 0.9-acre medium volume transfer station located at 9364 Glenoaks Blvd in Sun Valley, California.

On April 19, 2021 the LEA received from America's Recycling Company an application for a Registration Permit for a medium volume transfer station that could accept up to 100 tons per day of solid waste and operate Monday through Sunday from 5:00 am to 8:00 pm. The application package contained a completed registration permit application form, a facility plan, a notification letter to City Planning and a statement that no meetings were required for this project.

The LEA found that the application package meets the filing requirements pursuant to Section 18104.1 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations. The registration permit is a non-discretionary permit and does not require the applicant to submit evidence of CEQA compliance. Therefore, the LEA has issued a Registration Permit on May 19, 2021 to America's Recycling Company to operate a medium volume transfer station.
